**This will be on the agenda** for next meeting so public can attend.

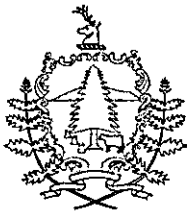
Audit has been received and we will discuss it at the budget meeting on the 1st meeting in January.

Shannon thought his first storm went well and he is working on the perfect salt mix. Battery in the tractor needs to be replaced. Board told him to buy new one.

**\*Water /Sewer** – We need to send a letter asking for a variance before months end asking for a variance. Jeff has talked about putting electricity up at the reservoir. Shannon was asked to go look at it and give an estimate. The manganese filters need to be washed and Jeff continues to wait for correct instructions to do so.

**\*Financials** –Delinquent taxpayers have all been sent a notice to pay. First budget meeting will be the 19<sup>th</sup> of January and the Audit will be discussed then. Permission was given for Mary to proceed with Woodsville Sweep Account at Woodsville Guarantee. As Brian will not be running for trustee in March it was decided only 2 signatures to be signed. By trustees and once by Mary Schilke.

**\*Public Comment/Other Business** –Brian Emerson will be stepping down as trustee at the March meeting. Everyone here holds him in the highest regard and wishes him well.
